CURBSIDE PARKING AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS RESTRICTIONS

Columbus Avenue from W.63rd Street to W.60th Street

MILLING AND RESURFACING

Beginning on/about Tuesday, October 4, 2016 7:00AM to 6:00 PM

Beginning on/about Tuesday, October 4, 2016, access to loading docks, driveways and curbside to curbside parking will be restricted along Columbus Avenue from West 63rd Street to West 60th Street. These impacts are associated with the scheduled milling and resurfacing work performed by the New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC). This is a mobile operation with work beginning at W.63rd Street. This work is scheduled to be completed in four (4) or five (5) days.

Traffic/Community Impacts:

- Parking restrictions will be in effect.
 - \circ "NO PARKING" signs will be posted in affected areas.
- Access to driveways will be restricted for approximately one (1) to two (2) days when work is performed in front of a business/residence.
- Certain operations will be noisy; DDC will monitor operations to assure that is within the DEP Noise Code regulations.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
