WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION

West End Avenue from W.59th Street to W.64th Street

Tuesday, February 7, 2017

At the following locations: 10 West End Avenue Element Condo Heschel School American Music & Drama Academy P.S. 191 Amsterdam Housing Complex 63 West United Cerebral Palsy of New York FROM 8:00PM TO 4:00AM

This shutdown should only affect the buildings listed above, on which the work is being performed.

If your location is not listed above, you SHOULD NOT BE AFFECTED by the water shutdown. If, for any unforeseen reason, your building sees a significant change in water service, please contact the Community Construction Liaison (CCL).

The NYC Department of Design and Construction is managing the capital construction project on West End Avenue from West 60th Street to West 62nd Street. To facilitate the installation of new 12" water main, a water shutdown is necessary. **The parameters are: West End Avenue from W.59th Street to W.64th Street**. The Shutdown will begin at **8:00PM, Tuesday, February 7, 2017** and last for approximately eight (8) hours performed by Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). On occasion, this work may be completed earlier and water service restored.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur if/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing.
- You are asked to shut off all <u>WATER</u> cooled appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a about 15 to 30 minutes.
