**This shutdown should only affect the buildings listed above, on which the work is being performed.**

If your location is not listed above, you **SHOULD NOT BE AFFECTED** by the water shutdown. If, for any unforeseen reason, your building sees a significant change in water service, please contact the Community Construction Liaison (CCL).

The NYC Department of Design and Construction is managing the capital construction project on West End Avenue from West 60<sup>th</sup> Street to West 62<sup>nd</sup> Street. To facilitate the installation of new 12" water main, a water shutdown is necessary. **The parameters are: West End Avenue from W.59<sup>th</sup> Street to W.64<sup>th</sup> Street.** The Shutdown will begin at **8:00PM, Tuesday, February 7, 2017** and last for approximately eight (8) hours performed by Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). On occasion, this work may be completed earlier and water service restored.

### SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur if/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing.
- You are asked to shut off all WATER cooled appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a about 15 to 30 minutes.
