### Street Closures and Traffic Restrictions

A large demonstration will be held at Columbus Circle and along Central Park West from 61<sup>st</sup> Street to 68<sup>th</sup> Street. There will be no parking in the area starting Sunday, February 19, 2017. Any cars parked in no parking zones will be towed. Additionally, street and sidewalk closures will occur.
