LINCOLN SQUARE BOW TIE Safety Improvements

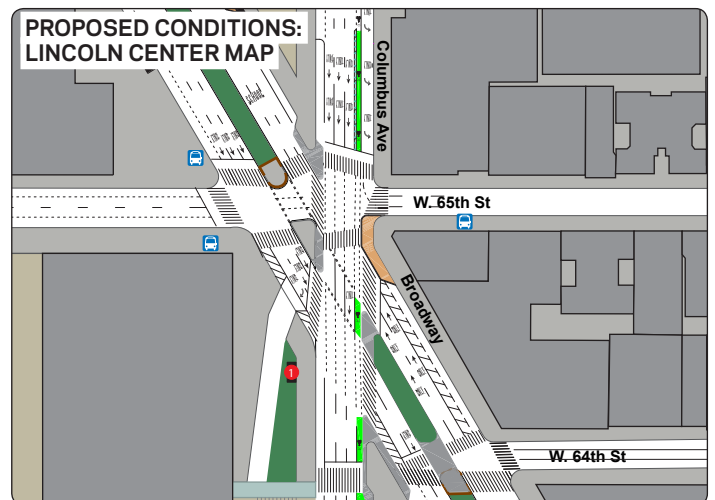
Relieve pedestrian congestion

Connect bicycle network

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements in the Lincoln Square Bow Tie, and on Columbus Ave. from W.69th St.-W.59th St.:

- Install more direct, safer pedestrian crossings and create new sidewalk space at congested pedestrian corners
- Install green painted, protected bicycle lanes on Columbus Ave. from W.69th to W.59th Streets
- Retime signals to remove pedestrian-vehicle conflicts on the east crosswalks at Columbus Avenue and W. 65th St.
- Install audible pedestrian signals
- Widen pedestrian cut-throughs at Broadway malls and address ponding concerns
- Relocate M7 bus stop to west side of Columbus Ave., between W. 66th St. and W.67th St.
- Relocate M20 bus stop to north side of W. 66th St., east of Columbus Ave.
- Ban left turn from Columbus Ave. to Broadway
- Ban right turn from northbound Broadway to 65th St., and ban left turn from southbound Broadway onto 64th St.

Implementation starts Late-July
