Winter's Eve at Lincoln Square – The Upper West Side's Favorite Foodie Festival Returns Monday, November 26, 2018

*Get in the holiday mood with comfort food and a smorgasbord of sweet treats

New York, NY - November 8, 2018 – Outdoor food festivals don't have to end just because the warm weather has. The 19th annual [Winter's Eve at Lincoln Square](#), New York's largest holiday festival, produced by the [Lincoln Square Business Improvement District](#) (BID), returns on Monday, November 26, 2018 from 5:30 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. At the event, from 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m., 34 of New York City's popular restaurants and eateries located in the Lincoln Square area will line the sidewalks of Lincoln Square offering savory samples, delectable desserts, hearty soups, hot drinks and signature dishes at nominal cost (\$1-\$4). The tastings will be held under tents in front of Time Warner Center at Columbus Circle, along Broadway between 62nd and 64th Streets and at Richard Tucker Park on Broadway between 65th and 66th Streets. The Outdoor Food Tastings are presented by [Glenwood](#) with support from **The Smith, PJ Clarke's, Rosa Mexicano, Bar Boulud, Boulud Sud and Epicerie Boulud**, and a portion of the evening's proceeds from all food and beverage sales will be donated to the [NY Cares Coat Drive](#), which is celebrating 30 years of keeping New York's most vulnerable of residents warm in the winter.

The highly-anticipated holiday festival is expected to attract more than 20,000 revelers to the Lincoln Square area of the Upper West Side including music enthusiasts, families and foodies. From chicken & andouille sausage gumbo to Moroccan lamb meatballs to lobster tacos, this year's dishes are as diverse and cultural as New York City itself.

New participants this year include the recently opened **Bluebird London**, New York City's favorite offbeat bakery **Momofuku Noodle Bar** and **Coffeed** a New York City-based, locally-sourced specialty coffee café.

Festival goers can keep warm with: Italian wedding soup from **Café Fiorello**; French onion soup from **Bar Boulud**; Moroccan lentil soup from **Nanoosh**; Chile con carne from **Porter House Bar and Grill**; hot spiced apple pear cider from **Dizzy's Club Coca-Cola**; pumpkin soup or veal stew by **La Boite en Bois**, and more.

Bring your appetites! There will be plenty of pasta in savory sauces. Toasted ricotta gnocchi with white truffle cream from **The Smith**, orecchiette alla norcina from **Landmarc** and creamy polenta with prosciutto from **Indie Food & Wine** are sure to be sell outs.

Just in time for the Feast of the Seven Fishes (an Italian-American Christmas tradition), there is no shortage of seafood this year including ahi tuna tostadas from **The Empire Rooftop**, salmon poke from **Atlantic Grill**, spicy tuna hand rolls from **Bar Masa** and more.

Winter's Eve is not complete without rugalach from **Breads Bakery** and chocolate bouchons from **Bouchon Bakery**. The growing list of participating restaurants features other neighborhood favorites including: **P.J. Clarke's**, **Rosa Mexicano**, **Gabriel's Bar & Restaurant**, **Sapphire Indian Cuisine** and more!

Food is certainly not the only thing to enjoy at Winter's Eve. The holiday celebration will feature more than 20 free live performances, multicultural dance troupes, strolling circus performers, ice-sculpting, and family fun. The event takes place in public spaces, in select indoor venues and along the sidewalks of Lincoln Square, the gateway to the Upper West Side, from Time Warner Center at Columbus Circle to 70th Street - in and around Broadway. Master of Ceremonies Judy Collins will join fellow folk icon Arlo Guthrie & The Guthrie Family, the Young People's Chorus of New York City, the Metropolitan Opera, and WABC-TV to kick off Winter's Eve with a traditional lighting of Lincoln Square's Upper West Side holiday tree.
