## **Change in Traffic Pattern Notice**

Amsterdam Avenue between W. 58th Street and W. 60th Street

### **EFFECTIVE MONDAY JULY 27, 2015**

To facilitate the water main work required in Amsterdam Avenue, from W. 58th Street to W. 60th Street, the New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) has reconfigured this work site.

There are now three (3) lanes on the west side of Amsterdam Avenue and one (1) lane of construction on the east side of the road. All crosswalks in the intersections of Amsterdam Avenue from W. 58<sup>th</sup> Street to W. 60<sup>th</sup> Street will be open. Please note: temporary closures may be necessary at times, as a safety precaution, and barrier set-up is subject to change, as needed.

# CURBSIDE PARKING AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS W.60th Street between West End Avenue and Amsterdam Avenue

Beginning on/about Monday, July 27, 2015 7:00AM to 6:00 PM

Beginning on/about Monday, July 27, 2015, access to driveways and curbside parking will be restricted along W.60th Street between West End Avenue and Amsterdam Avenue. These impacts are associated with the installation of curb and sidewalk, being performed by the New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC). This is a mobile operation with work beginning at the intersection of West End Avenue and W.60th Street and moving eastbound to Amsterdam Avenue; when completed, curbs and sidewalks installation will then be performed on the north side of W.60th Street.

#### **Traffic/Community Impacts:**

- Parking restrictions will be in effect.
  - "NO PARKING" signs will be posted in affected areas.
- Access to driveways will be restricted for approximately three (3) to five (5) days when work is performed in front of a business/residence.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
