## WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION

**Amsterdam Avenue from W.60<sup>th</sup> Street to W.61<sup>st</sup> Street**

Wednesday, October 26, 2016,  
8:00AM FOR 8 (EIGHT) HOURS

### WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF?

The NYC Department of Design and Construction is managing the capital construction project on Amsterdam Avenue from West 61<sup>st</sup> Street to West 60<sup>th</sup> Street. To facilitate the relocation of 12" water valve, a water shutdown is necessary. It will occur at/about 8:00am and last for approximately eight (8) hours. On occasion, this work may be completed earlier and water service restored.

### SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur if/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing.
- You are asked to shut off all WATER cooled appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a about 15 to 30 minutes.
