Traffic Pattern Change

9th Ave from W57th Street to W54th Street

On/About Monday June 22, 2020

WHY IS THE TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGING? To facilitate 12” distribution water main and 36” trunk water main installation required in conjunction with the Infrastructure Upgrade Along 9th Avenue Project. This operation is expected to be completed in two (2) months.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

There will be three (3) lanes of traffic plus the bike lane beginning at W57th Street. Construction operations will be in the West traffic lanes.

At the end of the days operation there will be four (4) lanes of traffic on the east-side of 9th Avenue plus the bike lane.

Temporary crosswalk closures may be necessary at times, as a precaution to assist in pedestrian traffic safety. Barrier(s) set-up is subject to change as needed.

Traffic Agents and Uniformed Flaggers will be on site to assist in the transition and daily operations.
